Michael Bailey, Chief of Police

Chief of Police Michael Bailey provides Council with an update of the 2020 accomplishments. He notes the increased training of officers, various grant opportunities that were secured, officers being more involved in community related public events and the effort to go paperless in the p.d. He provides the council with an overview of the productivity for the year highlighting the different incidents that were responded to by the police department. Chief Bailey is working to get the police department to be a participating member in the La Paz County Narcotics task force as a support agency.

1. Approve/Deny Arrowhead/Bronco Street Project

Steve Ziegler, Public Works Director

Director of Public Works Steve Zigler requests Mayor and Council to authorize staff to hire Sunland asphalt utilizing the 1 contract 17-16-05 for the base bid of \$251,988 an alternate #1 for \$131,033.76 for a combined total cost of \$383,021.76 for the demolition and construction of Arrowhead Avenue, Bronco Avenue, and 7th, 8th and 9th from Chemehuevi to Arrowhead Avenue and Bronco Avenue. Steve notes that this project was discussed at the March 2nd work session and during that work session he discussed the various changes that Atkins was faced with designing the streets and recommended the minimum that should be done in order to get the segments up to current industry standards and provide a longer life. He notes the project is scheduled to begin April 19th and take approximately three to four weeks to complete. Vice Mayor Hooper asks about the other alternatives, Steve notes they will not be doing alternate two or three that will become a project for the FYI 2021/2022 budget. He'd like to use the remaining funds in the streets capital budget to do the chip seal and crack sealing. Vice Mayor Hooper asks how soon into the new fiscal year this project will be taken care of? Steve hopes to do that very first thing in the fiscal year. He notes that the projects can be completed in the summer unlike the crack sealing which needs to be done in cooler weather. There are no other questions.


a. Community Development Projects
