

COVID-19 Coronavirus

The La Paz County Judicial Branch which includes the Parker Magistrate Court is committed to working with our legal community and the public to mitigate exposure.

***IF YOU FEEL ILL OR HAVE REASON TO BELIEVE THAT YOU HAVE BEEN EXPOSED TO SOMEONE WHO IS ILL, PLEASE EMAIL THE COURT FOR INSTRUCTIONS*.**

From now until April 30th, 2020, many procedures may be done by phone/email/fax to help promote social distancing and reduce the spread of the virus.

While you are welcome to come into the court, if you do not feel safe traveling or coming into the court please email us at: parkermagistrate@courts.az.gov or fax 928-669-5247 to see if you can be rescheduled or if we can do the appearance in another manner– also see the below information for initial appearances

If you have a civil traffic matter –

- 1) You can plea not responsible and request a telephonic hearing by email or fax. During this period, you will not have to get your driver's license picture size increased as long as it is readable when we receive it.
- 2) If you are already scheduled for a civil traffic hearing but did not get your form requesting a telephonic hearing to us in time, you can email your request with a copy of your driver's license.

If you have a misdemeanor criminal or criminal traffic matter, and it is not for a DUI or related to domestic violence and there is not an alleged victim –

- 1) You can plea not guilty by mail/email/fax. Include a readable copy of your driver's license. You will be set up for a pretrial conference within 30-60 days, upon receipt of your information.
- 2) You can also advise the court that you want to plea guilty by mail/email/fax. You will either receive a form for a telephonic guilty plea or you will receive an email advising that you must appear. You may also receive an order to get your fingerprints and photograph taken at the La Paz County Adult Detention Facility, prior to Judgment and Sentencing. If you receive such an order, please contact the La Paz County Adult Detention Facility, Parker, Az. for additional information, prior to going there.

You can pay your fines on-line at azcourtpay.com, www.parkermagistratepayments.com or you can call 1-855-839-6008. There is a small fee attached to these options. You can also mail in a payment by Money Order or Cashier's Check. Mail to: Parker Magistrate Court 1314 11th Street, Parker, Az. 85344.

For Protection Orders, please complete the forms at <https://azpoint.azcourts.gov>, then call the court to get a time to come in and see the judge or to set up a telephonic hearing. If you do not have access to the internet just come into the court but please call first.
