The restroom renovation was funded completely by the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). Approximately \$230,000.00 was allocated for the project. CDBG funds are allocated to rural communities across the state to revitalize lower income neighborhoods through housing rehabilitation, public facilities, infrastructure improvements and the provision of public services. The CDBG program has enriched lives by providing facilities and services where other financial resources were not available.
