- 1. Discussion and Action to Approve/Deny Resolution 09-2022 Bureau of Reclamation Water SMART Grant Application

Steve Ziegler, Public Works Director

Steve Zeigler, the Public Works Director, asks for the mayor and council to approve the application of submission for the BOR water SMART funding opportunity. He shows a presentation to the council for a demonstration on what the plan for town hall is and the police department. Zeigler explains who had submitted the application and what the grant is specifically for including why the grant would be beneficial. The grant is a 50/50 cost, the town will pay for half while the grant covers the rest. VM Hooper asked if the library will be included. Steve explained that he is in contact with the contractor and the library and that the library will look similar to how town hall and the police department will look.


